The retreat begins Thursday evening, July 7th, with check-in at 6:00 p.m. at Queen of All Saints Church. Transportation will be provided to and from the retreat center. The retreat concludes at the 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass at Queen of All Saints. A lunch reception will follow. Approximately 7–10 days prior to the retreat, you will receive a letter describing what to bring with you (clothing, pillows, etc.) for the weekend. Come experience discovery, renewal and peace with the women of Queen of All Saints and other area parishes.

A **deposit of \$50** is requested to reserve your place with the remaining \$185 registration fee due at check-in (the full amount is **\$235**). To register, please return your registration and deposit to the parish office. Please contact us if you have any further questions.
